#### **Instructors and Learners**



Upon successfully completing the course, each individual is eligible to receive a congratulatory letter from the Linux Professional Institute. This letter will document that the individual has completed the course. Please note there are no certifications for completing the NDG Linux courses.



#### Instructor's Guide

Log in to the course as an instructor.
Log in to the Cisco Networking Academy with your instructor credentials and click on the I'm Teaching tab.




On the I'm Teaching page, find the correct course and click to access the course. Scroll to find the relevant course and click on the course card.



#### 3. Enter the grades section.

In the course, click the **Grades** tab on the left side of the screen.




#### 4. Find the "Instructor Use Only Assign Student Pass Status" column.

Scroll to the right until you locate the assignment marked Instructor Use Only.




#### 5. Select the box for the student you wish to pass.

Select the grade box for the student you wish to grade and click the update grade icon located in the box on the right side.



#### 6. Update the grade to "Complete".


Select the appropriate grade in the drop-down box and click the **Update Grade** button.



Return to the NetAcad homepage to obtain the letter of completion for students.
Return to the NetAcad homepage by clicking the My NetAcad button, which can be found on the left.




7. Open the Course Details of the course for which you are providing the letter of completion. Click the Course Details button on the course card, under the *l'm Teaching* tab.




8. Refresh Grades to update completion status.

On the Course Details page, click on the Refresh Grades button.




#### 9. Filter for completed status.

Find the completion status column. Click on the **completion column** to open the completion filter drop-down menu.




#### 10. Select course completion status type.

Select the Completed Course option to filter for learners with course completed status.




#### 11. Obtain the letters of completion.

Click the **Get All Letters & Certificates** button to obtain all letters for eligible students. You may also obtain individual letters by clicking the **check-mark icon** in the *Get Certificate* column.



#### 12. Select an instructor to appear on the letter of completion.


If the course has multiple instructors, select the name of the instructor to appear on the certificate. Click Submit.


#### 13. Log in to the Cisco Networking Academy as a student.

After logging in, click your name, which can be found in the upper-right corner of the screen.



#### 14. Select "Certificates /Letters".

Click the button marked Certificates/Letters.



## 15. Obtain your Certificate.
